In order for the protective treatment to work properly, the right care and maintenance system must be used.



## **Regular Maintenance**



Lithofin MN Easy-Care cleans and maintains Marble and other natural stones in one easy operation. This highly concentrated special maintenance product does not leach out the stone or build up layers. With continued use, the stone will become slightly darker and richer in colour and appearance.

#### **Directions:**



Add one squirt (20ml) to one bucket of water.

Wipe surface with solution. Do not rinse.

Allow to dry. Do not walk on surface during drying time.

# Maintaining polished Marble

## Cleaning and refurbishing old surfaces

Use Lithofin MN Power-Clean to thoroughly clean old or very dirty surfaces.

- ➔ Depending on the degree of dirt, dilute Lithofin MN Power-Clean up to 1:3 with water. Apply with a scrubber or cloth and allow to work for 5 to 10 minutes.
- ➔ Brush well (with a scrubber or scrubbing machine) and wait another 5 minutes.
- Continue to scrub while adding water. Remove from the surface with a cloth or a wet-and-dry vacuum.
- → Rinse well with clear water in order to remove all product residues.
