Cleaning and Maintaining Sintered Surface Kitchen Bench Tops

Sintered surfaces are robust and will hold up to household chemicals. The very dense surface is easy to maintain and not prone to staining. In order to maintain these outstanding properties it is important to treat these surfaces correctly from the beginning.

Regular cleaning and maintenance



Every day cleaning during and after cooking is quick and easy with Lithofin KF HyClean. This special cleaner removes oil based dirt even encrusted grease effortlessly and without leaving streaks. Simply spray the surface and wipe up with a moist cloth after several minutes.



Hint: grease and oil should not remain on the surface for extended periods of time, since they will resinate and thereby become difficult to remove. We therefore recommend cleaning the bench top and splash back after cooking using the method described above.

Coloured food stuffs (wine, grapes, berries, etc.) should also be wiped up directly.

Removing stubborn dirt deposits

Felt and wax pens, paint, lacquer and similar stubborn stains can be removed with Lithofin WAX-OFF.

Metal abrasions caused by pots or knives can be removed by carefully scrubbing with cream cleansers.

Please Note: using abrasives and scouring pads may change the surface appearance

Hint: test in an inconspicuous area whether the cleaner you have chosen delivers the desired results.

Occasional deep cleaning

Even with the most careful maintenance regime, deposits and encrustations may appear over time. Especially the area around the sink is often affected by unsightly calcium deposits.

Clean these areas with Lithofin KF ClearTop from time to time. This operation will remove stubborn deposits and leave the surface clean and clear.

The products in this kit have been developed specifically for the use on kitchen work tops. They can be rinsed off the surface with water and therefore pose no health concerns.
