Neolith Sintered Stone | Size & Thickness

3mm is ideal for use as indoor furnishings in bathrooms, kitchens and on furniture such as tables, wardrobes/closets, doors and office partitions. This thickness is ideal for refurbishment projects. Being so thin, it can be placed directly on the existing surface without the need to extract, helping to reduce project execution times, costs and waste in landfills.

6mm is ideal for use in flooring, walls (both indoors and outdoors), stairs, pool surrounds and exterior facades.

12mm is ideal for kitchen and bathroom benchtops. This size allows for better utilisation of the surface, as well as reduced waste. For instance, one large slab can be utilised for two full average sized

20mm is ideal for kitchen benchtops. Inspired by a growing demand among designers and specifiers for thicker kitchen benchtops.
